CHIEF'S REPORT

We will miss Mike and thank him for his dedication to our personnel safety and our equipment.

NCRFA was notified by Snohomish County EMS (SCEMS) that they were moving in a different direction with the agency with fire service experienced contract employees with paramedic/EMS background and would no longer require the position filled by Kelly Fox. NCRFA noticed Kelly Fox of this direction by SCEMS and her services were no longer needed and as directed by SCEMS Board would be paid her severance per her contract.

Several recognitions of our personnel exhibiting the Core Values of the organization, Integrity, Innovation, Professionalism, Pride and Ownership:

Kayley Mizell, Katie Casey, and Rob Freedman for their coordination of another 9-11 recognition. The ROTC posted colors while Kari Wheeler sang an amazing rendition of the National Anthem finalized by the playing of Taps by David Spangler. The Arlington event was very nice also, attended by Councilpersons Schuette and Logan. The Scouts posted colors while Kari Wheeler again sang the National Anthem. A long-time Arlington citizen reached out to Chief Kraski last week requesting he be able to read a poem about 9-11 that he created that was heart felt and tearful. FFs Jacob Oesch and Mitch Kadlec did a great job of conducting the ringing of the "four/fives" bell during a moment of silence.

Innovation- over the past couple of weeks we have had dry, warm weather and low humidity acting as a recipe for brush fires. We experienced several during the period. Dan Welk receives the act of innovation recognition for this period. As Station 99 was toned for a wheat field on fire in Stanwood, FF/PM Welk looked at his captain and said grab the leaf blower. Capt. Booth didn't question his ask as they were readying for the call. As they arrived, FF Welk grabbed the blower while Capt. Booth walked the black assessing the rate of travel and tactics to communicate to incoming crews. FF Welk followed with the blower pushing out the trailing edge of the fire without a drop of water. DNR arrived and began to watch the operation and asked that they stop so that

they could film what they had been requesting as a tool for a while. They had the video proof to justify the extinguishment. As you know, one of the challenges on wildland fires is the lack of water.

Chief Cermak worked on the staff report for the City of Arlington ILA and with Rich Davis' review and position agreement. It will be important that he attends this meeting for this issue as there are legal implications for him to address. He was unable to attend this meeting. The question is whether the Board would like to have a special meeting or schedule Rich Davis for another meeting.

All NCRFA Chiefs and Administrative staff attended the monthly Battalion Chief's meeting as part of our communication plan.

The training center remains on target for target completion currently. County inspectors were very impressed with the state-of-the-art retention system at the recent inspection.

Chief Goforth and Chief Cermak attended a Rotary meeting in Stanwood.

Chief Kraski and Chief Cermak attended the Snohomish Fire Chiefs meeting. Wall times at hospitals are at unacceptable levels; the County Chiefs united and will send a letter to the appropriate people to help resolve this challenge. Some immediate steps have occurred to help the process.
