CHIEFS REPORT

We began Monday morning staff meetings and implemented a plan to continue weekly by zoom and once a month in person as our team is spread out and in different places.

Chief Kraski and Chief Cermak continued one on one meetings with crews. They are going well.

NCRFA received its LUCAS device received through a Firehouse Subs grant. Kudos to Doug ten Hoopen for making that happen. All grant requirements and news release have occurred.

There were multiple sessions with the Negotiations Board Committee to discuss non-represented contracts. Good progress was made to have those done in a timely manner.

A letter was sent to AFG SAFER, per the RFA annexation to notify them that we would be incurring the remainder of their grant obligation. City of Arlington was cc'd on that communication.

Chief Cermak attended the North County Chief's meeting

Chief Cermak reviewed multiple ILAs to move forward for the annexation requirements from Rich Davis' office. They will be moved forward to the City of Arlington for their City Council to review, then they will be presented to our RFA Board of Commissioners.

The RFA Annexation Team met several times discussing upcoming goals and timelines.

We met with the Labor Group regarding Impact Bargaining and potentially a new contract.

We Signed the Purchase Order and received lease final approval for new Pierce E46. All associated papers were completed and filed by Randy Krumm.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Commissioner Cade reported that the Blue Card Simulation Lab was held last week and all NCRFA officers are now certified. Now that the certifications have occurred he will step back and let Chief Smith continue with the program.
