Work was completed to purchase a new fire engine, Pierce Pumper, for Station 46 Arlington. It will be a 13-18 month build. The apparatus committee met one more time to complete the recommendation before you tonight.

The negotiations committee met regarding non-represented staff and corresponding work occurred to support.
