BC Smith provided an overview of some recent training with Arlington Fire and discussed the training needs that were discovered as a result of this training.

Steve Towers with Fire Service Repair stated that he went to the Pierce factory with AC Bartlett. He appreciated the opportunity because it solidified the stated changes that Pierce had been making in their product. He is confident it is a great product and will work well for NCRFA.

AC Makela was absent from the meeting however provided a one-page Community Risk Reduction report.

Randy Krumm provided a brief month end finance update

Chief Cermak noted that the Fire Impact Fee currently being charged by the City of Stanwood for new construction within City of Stanwood city limits may be going away. Chief Cermak asked the Board if they would like for he and Randy Krumm to address the fee and try to put together a new Fire Impact Fee that could potentially fund apparatus and/or capital needs. Commissioner Johnson stated that although he is not completely against a Fire Impact Fee, he does believe that if it is charged to those within city limits – the charge should also extend to those within unincorporated Snohomish County within the NCRFA borders as well. Chief Cermak discussed the impact on EMS when large clinics and retirement type structures are built within our service area. Commissioner Longley stated that he feels that if a Fire Impact Fee is going to be imposed, it should be done by zoning. Commissioner Williams would like for this to be addressed as a county-wide issue so builders/contractors don't steer away from one particular city due to the cost of the fees – if it were a county-wide fee it would eliminate the deterrence.

Commissioner Oakes asked the Board if they would like to host the Sno-Isle Commissioners meeting on April 2<sup>nd</sup> at Station 99. They agreed and will work on putting a menu together.

### **CHIEF'S REPORT**

Chief Cermak has spend quite a bit of time working on the training center project, the bond issuance, and participating on the RFA Annexation Committee

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

The RFA Annexation Committee has begun working together to explore the possibility of annexation with City of Arlington Fire. If this moves forward it's a possibility that it will be on the February 2021ballot.
